**Educational Outreach Training  
Wednesday, October 3, 2018**

*Educational Outreach Training will be held in conjunction with the Symposium. The purpose of this training is to empower high school teachers with strategies and course materials for use in their classrooms. The instructional materials will focus on these subjects: HIV/AIDS research, ethical biomedical research and the responsible use of animal models. 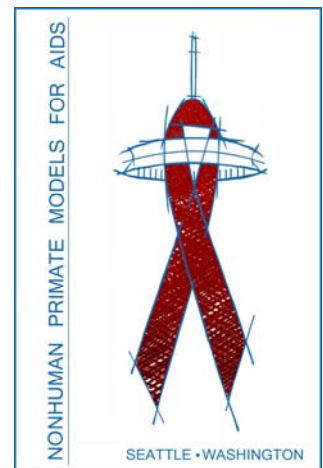
